Josh Robinson had an excellent weekend at the pre-Thanksgiving Tarkett Sports Classic, earning Tournament MVP honors after averaging 22.3 points to lead the Govs to a 2-1 record; he also earned OVC Player of the Week, TSWA Player of the Week and College Court Report's Fan Voted Player of the Week after his performance in Oxford.
