

2018 Franklin Rebels BOYS Middle School Team Camp

Hosted by Franklin High School Boys Basketball

CAMP GOALS

The purpose of this camp is to get kids into the gym during the summer and play against competition that they don't normally play against during the regular season. The camp is for players entering the 6th-8th grade for the 2018-2019 school year. Many colleges and universities hosting these camps may schedule middle school teams against high school JV teams. Our goal is to have as equal competition as possible. Teams will be classified as JV teams (6th and 7th graders) and Varsity teams (7th & 8th graders).

COMPETITION

Attempts have been made to get teams from surrounding counties including Davidson, Dickson, Hickman, Maury, Rutherford, Sumner, Wilson, Williamson, etc. so coaches can see how their teams stack up against teams they don't usually compete against.

DATES & TIMES

Camp will be held on June 21st (Thursday) and June 22nd (Friday). Games will begin at 8:00 or 9:00AM and end around 3:00 or 4:00 in the afternoon. Every effort is made not to conflict with evening activities.

FACILITIES

All games will be played on the campus of Franklin High School. Franklin High boasts two full-court gymnasiums for all games. There will be no cross-court games or confusing whistles from the next court.

OFFICIALS

Two quality officials will be utilized in every game.

COST

Each school can play one or two days. There will be three games per day for each team. Cost (per team) for the camp is \$150 for the first day or \$250 for both days. You may bring as many players as you wish. There is no player fee. We will limit the camp to the first 12 teams to respond. To ensure your spot, please send in your entry form ASAP. RULES

Games will consist of four 8-minute quarters. The clock will stop on all shooting fouls, time-outs, the last 10 seconds of the first three quarters, and the last 2 minutes of the fourth quarter. Teams will receive three timeouts per game. Bonus and double bonus will be shot the last two minutes of the first and second halves. In case of a tie at the end of regulation, sudden death overtime will be used with the winning team the first to score.

OTHER

Franklin High School is within 2 minutes of a dozen or more restaurants for you and your team to enjoy lunch. There will also be a camp store available where snacks and drinks may be purchased.
